
AT THE LIBRARY

GTSB GRANT ENFORCEMENT

For many years the Waukeee Police Department has worked with the Governor's Traffic Safety Bureau to help promote safety in our community. Each year the Police Department applies for grants to aid us in obtaining equipment, paying officer's overtime and providing additional officer training.

During the course of the year, we are required to have special enforcement days to help target specific areas of concern regarding the Governor's Traffic Safety Bureau, including child restraints, seat belts, speed, O.W.I. Enforcement, etc. The next special enforcement program will be held May 20 to June 2, 2013.

VANDALISM AT THE CITY PARKS

Vandalism in the city parks will not be tolerated. Persons caught doing any vandalism to the city parks will be dealt with very severely. Criminal charges will be filed as well as restitution for any damage done.

TRAFFIC ON PARK STREET

With Park Street being widened and traffic flowing both directions the speed limit is still 15 MPH. We have clocked drivers up to 43 MPH and driving recklessly. THIS WILL NOT BE TOLERATED.
