Waukeee Police and Fire Departments Announce Public Safety Day

Waukeee, Iowa—The Waukeee Police and Fire Departments are hosting a Public Safety Day for the community on Thursday, June 12, 2014, from 5:00 p.m. to 8:00 p.m. at the Waukeee Public Safety Building located at 1300 LA Grant Parkway.

The event will feature an array of activities and demonstrations, including a child safety seat check, tours of the public safety building, the chance for kids to use a fire hose, the opportunity to try Fatal Vision goggles—which simulate what impaired driving feels like, along with a child ID station where parents can have an ID made in case of emergencies.

Attendees can meet police and fire personnel, Waukeee Mayor Bill Peard, City Council members, and other City leaders. All food and drink will be provided by the Waukeee Police and Fire Departments with Fareway grilling hot dogs and hamburgers, and Atlantic Bottling supplying refreshments.

A complete list of activities is detailed below:

- Child safety seat check and installation
- Child ID's for children under the age of 10
- Fatal Vision goggle use
- Obstacle Course (must be over 18 years of age)
- A demonstration of a roll-over without the use of a seat belt
- Fire extinguisher demonstration
- Dummy drag
- Kids using a fire hose

- Tours of the Public Safety Building
- McGruff the crime fighting dog will make an appearance
- Buckle Bear the robot will make an appearance
