Waukeee Police and Fire Departments Announce Public Safety Day

Waukeee, Iowa—The Waukeee Police and Fire Departments are hosting a Public Safety Day for the community on Tuesday, August 4, 2015 from 5:00 p.m. to 8:00 p.m. at the Waukeee Public Safety Building located at 1300 LA Grant Parkway.

The event will feature an array of activities and demonstrations including a child safety seat check, tours of the public safety building, the chance for kids to use a fire hose, the opportunity to try Fatal Vision goggles (impaired driving simulation tool) and a child ID station where parents can have an ID made in case of emergencies.

Attendees can meet police and fire personnel, elected officials and other City leaders. All food and drinks will be provided by the Waukeee Police and Fire Departments with Fareway grilling hot dogs and hamburgers, and Atlantic Bottling supplying refreshments.
