If such a meeting shall take place, "the nature of the good cause justifying the departure from the normal requirements (of 24 hour notice by posting) shall be stated in the minutes.

Any member of the public who would like to ask questions or make comments may participate by using the RAISE HAND feature. Participants must be recognized by the presiding officer and must state their full name and address before addressing the Park Board. The Chat and Q&A functions will be turned off during the meeting.
