This is not a planned regular or special meetings of the Waukeee City Council. It is, however, a meeting where three or more council members may be present and where policy may be discussed. If such a meeting shall take place, "the nature of the good cause justifying the departure from the normal requirements (of 24-hour notice by posting) shall be stated in the minutes.
