**Trout Day at Triumph Park**

*Originally scheduled for Saturday, April 1; stocking now Monday, April 3*

Waukee, IA – Due to high winds and snow in northern Iowa, the Iowa Department of Natural Resources is unable to stock the pond at Triumph Park on Saturday, April 1. Therefore, the Trout Day event is changing form. The event for Saturday, April 1 is cancelled, but residents and visitors are invited to watch the Iowa DNR stock the pond on Monday, April 3 (weather permitting) and to cast a line to catch one of the specially tagged fish.

**Catch a Prize Fish**

Whenever you catch a tagged fish, snap a photo of the fish with the tag and email it to Waukee Parks and Recreation at [parksandrecreation@waukee.org](mailto:parksandrecreation@waukee.org). Tags can be redeemed for a prize generously donated by Scheels, Bass Pro Shops or Fleet Farm, including fishing poles, tackle boxes and more! The Parks and Recreation team will accept tags as long as the trout are biting, but get out to Triumph Park soon to have the best odds. **Fishing Reminders**

A valid fishing license and trout stamp are required for those 16 years or older. Find more details on trout limits and requirements on the [DNR website](#). In Waukee, residents and visitors can purchase fishing licenses in-person at Fleet Farm, located at 1300 SE Kettlestone Blvd.

Please keep the trout you catch and do not release them back to the pond. Trout are not native to Iowa and are unlikely to survive the summer, so take them home and make a tasty dinner.
